Questions & Answers 1

Question 1

Will this web site cover all kinds of green jobs, or be limited to jobs in the green design and green building sector? Will there be a particular area of emphasis?

Answer

It will cover green jobs in all sub-sectors of the green economy - green building, energy, transportation, manufacturing and environment.

Question 2

In two places (*Project Scope and Conditions, third paragraph* and *Application Requirements, last paragraph*) the RFQ references “course content” and “course developers”. Is this use of the word “course” in reference to a specific training function of the web site, such as hosting an online course or webinar?

Answer

No, the wording is referring to content development at this time. It is anticipated the site will link to available online courses and materials.

Question 3

Under *Application Requirements, last paragraph*, the RFQ states that selections will be made on an “as-needed” basis. What is meant by “as-needed”? We are aware that submitting a proposal is not a guarantee of winning the work.

Answer

That indicates that responders to this RFQ may be included in future RFP or RFQ solicitations that are released as needed by the WDC.

Question 4

Who will be responsible for creating or procuring the graphic elements of the web site (including photos and/or highly graphical elements like diagrams)?

Answer

This is expected to be part of the web developer’s work.

Question 5

We understand that a third-party web site developer will be responsible for building the site and that the RFQ is solely for content development. However, the type of content developed can relate to the type of

technology used. Can you describe any specific web technologies you might plan to use, such as JavaScript, Flash, social media, or other technology-based forms of interactivity?

Answer

The site content will not be interactive.
